**Missouri Weekly Hay Summary**

Regardless of what crop farmers in the state are trying to produce, all are suffering from excessive moisture and cool temperatures which are delaying growth or preventing planting. A very small amount of hay has been baled in the state and growth reported as being short. A very limited number of new crop prices reported seem to be somewhat encouraging to the producer given the significant increase in production inputs. Demand for new crop hay is good as several buyers have the mind set to get it bought early and end the worry about all the unknowns that might occur before snow flies again. Many pastures are short as grass just can't keep up with grazing which is forcing some to graze areas they would prefer to bale. Hay prices are firm as new crop prices try to establish themselves; the supply and demand is moderate.
