Many areas in the state continue to have an ample supply of mud which is prohibiting field work of any kind. As typical for this time of year the weather continues to go from one extreme to the other but longer days have pulled many plants out of dormancy allowing tints of green to show up in more of the state. Hay movement is light and with feeding days winding down farmers finding interest dwindling, not that interest was anything to write home about at any point this past feeding season. The supply of hay is moderate to heavy, demand light and prices steady to weak as the hay market is seeing the same pressures as every other sector of the economy.
