**Week Ending June 12, 2011 Agricultural Summary**

**Agricultural Summary** Field preparation, planting, and replanting continued in full force as dry weather pushed farmers to take advantage of the **5.7 days suitable for fieldwork**. Storms causing hail damage in the north-central and northeast districts limited fieldwork, but the southwest and south-central districts enjoyed nearly 7 days suitable for fieldwork. Flooding concerns continued with bottom lands flooded along the Mississippi above St. Louis and seepage becoming apparent along the Missouri River north of Kansas City. However, warm weather and little precipitation reduced statewide **topsoil moisture supply** to 2 percent very short, 21 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. **Spring tillage** was 97 percent complete with the southeast district (Bootheel) at 91 percent, still feeling the delays from early season flooding. **Field Crops Report** **Corn** emergence was 97 percent, 3 days ahead of last year, and 11 days ahead of the 5-year historic average (normal). Although the weather was warmer than average, corn condition was 2 percent very poor, 6 percent poor, 30 percent fair, 52 percent good, and 10 percent excellent. **Soybeans** progressed 18 points from last week to 77 percent planted, 6 days ahead of 2010 and 5 days ahead of normal. Emergence was 58 percent, nearly the same as last year and normal. Soybean condition was 4 percent poor, 31 percent fair, 59 percent good, and 6 percent excellent. **Wheat** condition was 9 percent very poor, 16 percent poor, 31 percent fair, 37 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. The Bootheel remained similar to last week with 57 percent in the very poor, and poor categories, and 43 percent in the fair and good categories. Winter wheat turning color was 93 percent, 8 days ahead of last year, and 6 days ahead of normal. Harvest was nearly the same as last year and normal at 9 percent, with 21 percent of wheat in the Bootheel harvested. The first cutting for **alfalfa hay** advanced 25 points to 78 percent, 13 days ahead of last year, and 3 days ahead of normal. The second cutting for alfalfa hay was 4 percent complete, 1 week behind last year, and 1 day behind normal. **Other hay** cutting moved 17 points, to 44 percent, 2 days ahead of last year, but 1 day behind of normal. **Pasture & Livestock Pasture condition** declined slightly from last week to 4 percent poor, 33 percent fair, 57 percent good, and 6 percent excellent.
