Missouri Weekly Hay Summary Week ending 10/11/2013

Despite the cool, crisp mornings the warm, sunny afternoons have kept grass in good condition. Even those areas where the late summer heat took pastures down to nothing have seen some renewal. The market for hay is still seeing very little price test. This week the lack of hay movement is attributable to the hustle and bustle of harvest in addition to the lack of demand for hay.
