Week Ending November 10, 2013 Agricultural Summary

There were 4.2 **days suitable for fieldwork**. **Topsoil moisture supply** was 4 percent very short, 18 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. **Subsoil moisture supply** was 18 percent very short, 30 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. **Fall tillage** was 50 percent complete, 24 days behind last year and 8 days behind normal (5-year average). **Field Crops Report Corn** harvested was 89 percent complete, 39 days behind last year but 3 days ahead of normal. **Corn moisture at harvest** was 16.3 percent, ranging from 14.2 percent in the southwest district to 16.7 percent in the north-central district. **Soybeans** mature were 99 percent, the same as last year and normal. Soybeans harvested were 75 percent complete, 8 days behind last year and 6 days behind normal. **Cotton** opening bolls was 99 percent complete. Cotton harvested was 64 percent complete, 18 days behind last year and 17 days behind normal. **Sorghum** harvested was 86 percent complete, 7 days behind last year but 4 days ahead of normal. **Winter wheat** planting was 76 percent complete, 9 days behind last year and 2 days behind normal. Winter wheat emerged was 58 percent complete, 7 days behind last year but the same as normal. Winter wheat condition was 1 percent poor, 52 percent fair, 45 percent good, and 2 percent excellent. **Pasture & Livestock Pasture** condition was 3 percent very poor, 17 percent poor, 52 percent fair, 26 percent good, and 2 percent excellent. **Supply of hay and other roughages** was 1 percent very short, 7 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. In Webster County a few hay fields were cut in hopes of freeze drying it for baling. **Stock water supplies** were 2 percent very short, 14 percent short, 81 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. **Weather Summary Temperatures** ranged from 2 degrees below average to 2 degrees above average across the state. Precipitation averaged 0.94 of an inch statewide.
