Missouri Crop Progress and Condition Report
05/25/2014

Warm temperatures allowed soybean planting to reach 61 percent complete, 29 percentage points above the previous week. There were 5.3 days suitable for fieldwork during the week ending May 25. Statewide average temperature was 70.1 degrees, which is 3.3 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 0.42 inches statewide, with only scattered areas reporting rain. Corn planting progressed to 97 percent complete, up 16 percentage points from last year and up 9 percentage points the 5-year average. Corn emerged progressed to 88 percent which is 35 percentage points ahead of last year and 17 percentage points ahead of the 5-year average. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent very short, 21 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 10 percent very short, 31 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Winter wheat progressed to 88 percent headed. Winter wheat condition was rated 2 percent very poor, 9 percent poor, 38 percent fair, 44 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. Soybeans emerged progressed to 34 percent, up 24 percentage points from last week. Rice planting progressed to 95 percent complete. Rice emerged progressed to 84 percent. Cotton planting progressed to 91 percent complete, up 29 percentage points from last week. Pasture condition was rated 2 percent very poor, 12 percent poor, 49 percent fair, 34 percent good, and 3 percent excellent.
