**Missouri Crop Progress and Condition**  
**November 24, 2014**

Corn and soybean harvest neared completion last week. Temperatures across the state averaged 32.9 degrees for the week, which is 10.4 degrees below normal. Precipitation averaged 0.27 inches statewide. There were 4.9 days suitable for fieldwork during the week ending November 23. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 1 percent very short, 13 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 17 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Corn harvest was 94 percent complete. Soybean harvest was 95 percent complete. Winter wheat planted progressed to 94 percent. Winter wheat emerged progressed to 74 percent. Cotton harvest was 91 percent complete. Fall tillage progressed to 54 percent. Pasture condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 12 percent poor, 39 percent fair, 42 percent good, and 6 percent excellent.
