Missouri Crop Progress and Condition (11/23/15)

Heavy rain fell across most of Missouri with some areas receiving more than 5 inches of precipitation last week. Temperatures averaged 44.9 degrees, 1.3 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 4.28 inches statewide, 3.37 inches above normal. There were 2.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending November 22. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 15 percent short, 71 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 6 percent very short, 21 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Soybean harvest was 96 percent complete, compared to 94 percent last year and 96 percent for the 5-year average. Cotton harvest was 92 percent complete. Sorghum harvest was 94 percent complete. Winter wheat planted reached 96 percent. Winter wheat emerged reached 90 percent, compared to 72 percent last year and 82 percent for the 5-year average.
