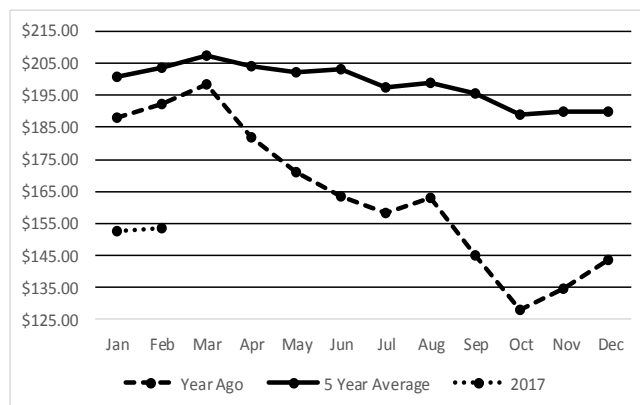

Hay movement continues to be pretty slow, most farmers have plenty in the way of supply for the remainder of the feeding season and the fact that spring seems to be arriving early makes those days to turn out even closer.
