Credibility and Merit:	(30 Points Possible) Project principles must be able to demonstrate the capability and qualifications to deliver the desired results and implement the proposed actions. In cases where delivery is dependent upon volunteers or consumers, commitment and demand must be demonstrated. Measureable outcomes should be included.					
Impact Potential:	(30 Points Possible) Projects must clearly define the scope, purpose and impact in the local food insecure area and be able to demonstrate an immediate need and lack of existing service or resource availability.

Matching Funds:	(10 Points Possible) Projects must meet a minimum \$0.25:\$1 match. Matching funds can be cash and in-kind. A cash match must be greater than 50% of the total match for eligibility. Only receipts within the grant period will be accepted.					
Timeliness:	(10 Points Possible) Projects must demonstrate a reasonable and feasible work plan and time for delivery. Projects will be graded on the immediacy of impact within the local food insecure area.					
Partner Support:	(20 Points Possible) Projects must show matching partner support through letters of commitment that define the kind and type of support planned.

 - Matching funds must equal a \$0.25:1 match to the grant funds requested for reimbursement.
 Matching funds can be cash match and in-kind match, however, cash match must be greater than 50% of the total match provided.
- The project described in the application must be completed and ready for inspection by MDA staff no later than May 1, 2020.
- Reimbursements will only be completed once all required documentation has been received and a site inspection has been completed by MDA staff. Site inspections will be completed by June 1, 2020.
- Failure to submit the required documentation by May 1, 2020 will result in the forfeiture of funds.
