

Missouri Senior & WIC Farmers Market Nutrition Program Farmer Requirements

The Missouri Senior & WIC Farmers Market Nutrition Program (MO S/FMNP) provides funds to low-income seniors and families who receive WIC benefits to purchase eligible foods from an authorized vendor at a farmers market. Participating seniors receive \$50 in benefits and each individual in the WIC program receives \$30 in benefits.

Program Dates:

May 1 - Oct. 30

To be authorized, farmers must:

- Live and grow in Missouri, or a Kansas or Illinois county that borders Missouri.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Grow at least 50% of what you sell at the farmers' market.
- Complete annual virtual training provided by the Missouri Department of Agriculture.
- Sell at a farmers market or roadside stand in at least one of the listed counties.
- Have a smart device.
