Notes:

1. Required by Missouri entry regulations for dairy.
2. May be more stringent than ADT as determined by state of destination for beef and dairy.
3. ID females (all ages) and males/steers born after March 11, 2013.
4. To move out of state female dairy (any age) and males/steers born after March 11, 2013, must have been identified to the original owner prior to co-mingling.
