Economic Contributions of Agriculture, Forestry & Related Industries:

Sales: \$126.5 million

Jobs: 1,173

Value-Added: \$61.8 million

Labor Income: \$29.1 million

Inputs: \$64.6 million

Taxes: \$8.5 million

Sales: The broadest measure of economic activity - often referred to as "output"; **Employment (Jobs):** A measure of job positions without regard to whether they are full-time equivalents; **Value-Added:** Sales (output) minus the cost of inputs; **Taxes:** Includes taxes paid at the federal, state and local levels.

Overall Contributions to Linn County

Agricultural, forestry, and related industries support 1,173 jobs in Linn County. Additionally, these industries contribute \$126.5 million in sales, which translates to \$61.8 million in added value to the area after \$64.6 million worth of inputs are purchased. Of this \$61.8 million, \$29.1 million is comprised of labor income. Tax revenues generated by the agricultural, forestry, and related industries in Linn County are \$8.5 million.
