# Missouri Agriculture USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) offers disaster assistance to assist agricultural producers in recovery efforts following floods or similar qualifying natural disasters.



## Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP)

Provides financial assistance to producers of non-insurable crops when low yields, loss of inventory or prevented planting occur due to natural disasters (includes native grass for grazing). Eligible producers must have purchased Non-Insured Crop Disaster Assistance Program coverage for 2017 crops.



### Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP)

Offers payments to eligible producers for livestock death losses in excess of normal mortality due to adverse weather. Eligible losses may include those determined by FSA to have been caused by hurricanes, floods, blizzards, wildfires, tropical storms, tornados, lightning, extreme heat and extreme cold. Producers will be required to provide verifiable documentation of death losses resulting from an eligible adverse weather event and must submit a notice of loss to their local FSA office within 30 calendar days of when the loss of livestock is apparent.



### **Tree Assistance Program**

Provides assistance to eligible orchardists and nursery tree growers for qualifying tree, shrub and vine losses due to natural disaster.



# Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-Raised Fish Program (ELAP)

Provides emergency relief for losses due to feed or water shortages, disease, adverse weather or other conditions, which are not adequately addressed by other disaster programs. ELAP covers physically damaged or destroyed livestock feed that was purchased or mechanically harvested forage or feedstuffs intended for use as feed for the producer's eligible livestock. In order to be considered eligible, harvested forage must be baled; forage that is only cut, raked or windrowed is not eligible. Producers must submit a notice of loss to their local FSA office within 30 calendar days of when the loss is apparent. ELAP also covers up to 150 lost grazing days in instances when a producer has been forced to remove livestock from a grazing pasture due to floodwaters. For beekeepers, ELAP covers beehive losses (the physical structure) in instances where the hive has been destroyed by a natural disaster, including flooding, high winds and tornadoes.



# **Emergency Loan Program**

Available to producers with agriculture operations located in a county under a primary or contiguous Secretarial Disaster designation. These low-interest loans help producers recover from production and physical losses due to drought and flooding.



# **Emergency Conservation Program**

Provides emergency funding for farmers and ranchers to rehabilitate land severely damaged by natural disasters; including fence loss.

# **Upcoming FSA Deadlines**

#### May 1 - July 15

- Conservation Reserve
Program: No maintenance
(mowing, spraying, burning
or disking) on acreage in the
Conservation Reserve Program
(CRP) because this is the
beginning of the primary nesting
season for Missouri.

#### May 15

- **Spring oats & potatoes:** final date to report.

#### **Ongoing**

- Failed Acreage: reports must be filed with the county office before disposition of the crop.
- Prevented Planting: acreage reports must be filed with the County Office no later than 15 calendar days after the final planting date for that county.
- Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-Raised Fish Program (ELAP): reports of loss under the ELAP must be filed within 30 days after the loss is apparent.
- Livestock Indemnity
  Program (LIP): reports of
  livestock deaths (due to adverse
  weather) under the LIP must
  be filed within 30 days after the
  death is apparent. An application
  for payment must be filed no
  later than 90 calendar days after
  the end of the calendar year in
  which the eligible loss condition
  occurred
- Noninsured Crop Disaster Program (NAP): report any losses for the within 15 days of when the loss becomes apparent.
