Schedule of Fees Unofficial Inspection and Weighing Services Not Provided Under USGSA or AMA Page 1

Effective Date: August 1, 2025. This revised fee schedule supersedes all prior fee schedules issued by this agency.

Labor Rates:

Regular:	\$30.00 per hour
Any work between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. M	londay through Friday, except holidays.
Saturday/Overtime:Any work performed on Saturdays, and any	\$45.00 per hour work outside of regular hours Monday through Friday.
Sunday/Holiday: Any work performed on Sundays, and any d	\$60.00 per hour ay designated as a holiday by the Governor of Missouri.

Except where indicated, fees for service do not include hourly labor charges:

Unofficial Certified Weighing Service Fees:

Railcar:	\$6.50 per unit
Truck/Trailer:	\$6.50 per unit
Container:	\$6.50 per unit
Totes/Sacks:	\$3.25 per unit
Barge:	\$3.25 per 1000 bushels

Weighmaster License Fee: \$25.00 per license, plus any applicable hourly fees and/or mileage if requiring inspection staff travel.

Grain Grading School Fees: Flat rate of \$100.00 for supplies and preparation, plus \$50.00 per Inspector, per hour, plus applicable mileage. Additional hourly rate starts from the time Inspector leaves domicile until they return.
