PROPOSED RESCISSION

2 CSR 50-6.040 Contracts to Provide Entertainment at the State Fair *This rule provided for the director of the Missouri State Fair to arrange for various forms of entertainment and informational exhibits for the fair.*

PURPOSE: The rule is being rescinded as the rule is outdated and obsolete. Current fair policies and contracts adopted by the commission dictate entertainment details.

AUTHORITY: Chapter 262 and section 262.270, RSMo Supp. 1987. Original rule filed April 2, 1992, effective Jan. 15, 1993.*

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
