Proposed Rescission

2 CSR 80-3.130 Adoption of the Grade “A” Pasteurized Milk Ordinance (PMO), 2015 Revision of the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service, Food and Drug Administration by Reference. The Grade “A” Milk Ordinance (PMO), 2015 Revision of the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service, Food and Drug Administration is a recommended ordinance for adoption by state and local governments for the sanitary control of Grade “A” milk and milk products.

Purpose: This proposed rescission eliminates unnecessary duplication of portions of the Pasteurized Milk Ordinance that is adopted by reference.
